Scope (Target audience)

The course is designed for personnel that have some experience in the role of Barge Supervisor or as part of the control team during emergencies and are seeking refinement in their leadership role and validation assessment of their skills in this area.

Objective

- O Construction and design
- o Emergency procedures and safety equipment
- o Communications
- Safe working practices
- o Handling and stowage of supplies, including dangerous cargo
- Meteorology
- Pollution prevention and control
- o Regulatory and certification requirements
- o Emergency first aid
- Transit operations
- o Seamanship

- o ID Card or passport
- o 2 passport-sized color photographs
- o Medical exam (not older than 12 months)
