

# Offshore Installation Manager - MOU

Course code: OIM

Certification (Approvals): Liberian Maritime Authority, Marshall Islands, Republic of Vanuatu, Croatian Register of Shipping (CRS)

### Scope (Target audience)

The course is conducted in accordance to the requirements of sec.6.2 of IMO Res. A.1079 (28). The course is designed for personnel that have some experience in the role of OIM or as part of the control team during emergencies and are seeking refinement in their emergency leadership role and validation assessment of their skills in this area.

# **Objective**

The purpose of this course is to enable prospective and incumbent candidates for the position of OIM or Deputy to implement and practice the procedures required to manage emergencies that may be encountered on an offshore platform and drill rig.

#### **Course Content**

- o Stability and construction
- o Station-keeping, mooring and dynamic positioning
- o Transit operations
- o Emergency procedures and safety equipment
- o Personnel transfers
- o Handling of stowage of supplies, including dangerous goods
- o Pollution prevention and control
- o Meteorology
- o Safe working practices
- o Regulatory and certification requirements
- o Industrial operations as they relate to maritime safety, including appreciation of their interrelationship between marine operations and specific industrial activities

# **Prerequisite**

- o ID Card or passport
- o 2 passport-sized color photographs
- Medical exam (not older than 12 months)

Minimum number of Candidates: 5

Validation: 5 years
